Transguard literacy initiative reads well

Recognised qualifications and better career prospects drive 8,000 workers to excel during English language lessons, part of company - sponsored literacy project

Transguard, an Emirates Group company, is celebrating a record year for its English training department.

Lynne McMurray, Executive Director at Transguard says: "At Transguard, we pay more than lip service to our commitment to ensuring staff training is practical, accessible and beneficial. We have seen a doubling of staff taking up our English lessons in the last few months – and we are witnessing increasing success rates."

English language training is provided through the "Common European Framework"

which leads to officially, and internationally recognised qualifications in the form of an

IELTS certification.

On joining Transguard, all staff members are tested for their English proficiency and

those who excel are encouraged to take an internationally recognised Cambridge

University English exam.

The language training centre also offers 96 hour development courses, for rapid

language training, as well as a range of self- and home-study opportunities.

Another unique Transguard initiative is "The Conversation Club". Launched at the start

of 2011, the club has met with extraordinary success. All levels of staff come together

to chat in English; watch films and read in a relaxed, comfortable environment.

Transguard also provides staff living in its accommodation blocks with access to a

library of some 1300 novels, as well as current magazines and daily newspapers.
